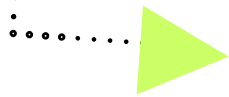

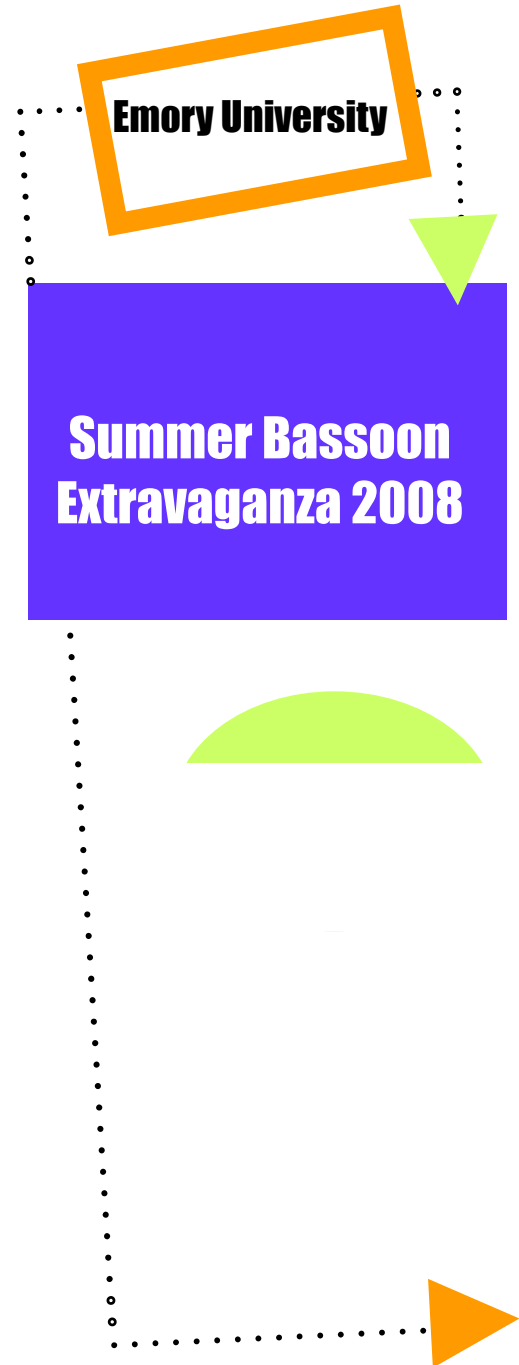

Summer Bassoon Extravaganza 2008

Summer Bassoon Extravaganza is a weeklong experience that features bassoon and contrabassoon master classes, instruction in reed making, chamber music and a bassoon choir. The camp is designed for aspiring bassoonists grades 7th-12th, as well as developing adults. Once again, the camp will be held at Emory University. Emory is recognized internationally as an inquiry-driven, ethically engaged, and diverse community whose members work for positive transformation in the world. Nestled in the peaceful, tree-lined suburban neighborhood of Druid Hills, Emory will quickly become home away from home. The camp package includes all camp activities (e.g. master classes, coaching, chamber music, bassoon choir, room and board, and redesigned 2008 SBE T-shirt). Campers will have access to the Emory-Woodruff PE center and campus security. The week culminates in performances by faculty and students.



The in-residence faculty for SBE 2008 will be:

Jennifer Brinson, a freelance bassoonist, private instructor, and clinician, is in her second year as a band director. She is pursuing a master's degree in bassoon performance at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Michael Dicker is a full-time resident professor of bassoon at Illinois State University, principal bassoonist with the Peoria Symphony and member of the Sonneries quintet.

Marita Abner, longtime bassoonist with the Kansas City Symphony and bassoon instructor at the University of Missouri Kansas City, joins the SBE faculty this season.

Roger Soren has been the contra bassoonist/assistant bassoonist with the Louisville Symphony Orchestra since 1989, and Adjunct Lecturer of Music at Indiana University since 2004, where he teaches reed making, contrabassoon and bassoon.

Shelly Unger, founding director of SBE, is a freelance player, private teacher and an Artist Affiliate Bassoon Instructor at Emory. She is nearing completion of her DMA in bassoon performance from The University of Georgia.

Guest artists and clinicians include:

William D. Davis is professor of bassoon and assistant director of the Hugh Hodgson School of Music at The University of Georgia.

Juan de Gomar, contrabassoonist with the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra, can also be heard on the Bassoon Brothers popular CDs *Captured!* and *Wanted*.

Laura Najarian, currently second bassoonist with the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra, formally principal bassoonist with the Savannah Symphony (1989-2003).

Carl Nitchie, longtime principal bassoonist with the ASO, is also an Artist Affiliate Bassoon Instructor at Emory University.

Dr. Scott A. Stewart, director of instrumental music at Emory University, also conducts the SBE Bassoon Choir.
